



Anti Slavery Policy

Purpose

- 1.1 Corehard Limited ("the Company") is committed to the practice of responsible corporate behaviour.
- 1.2 Through its business practices the Company seeks to protect and promote the human rights and basic freedoms of all its employees and agents.
- 1.3 Further the Company is committed to protecting the rights of all of those whose work contributes to the success of the Company, including those employees and agents of suppliers to the Company.
- 1.4 This policy is non-exhaustive, and all aspects of the Company's business should be considered in the spirit of this policy.

It is our approach to comply with all laws and regulations relevant to our business in all countries where we operate. Following the implementation of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, Corehard Limited is committed to maintaining and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure modern slavery is not taking place within our own business or in any of our supply chains.

Modern slavery is a criminal activity and a violation of human rights. The deprivation of a person's liberty by another in order to exploit them for personal or commercial gain is unacceptable. For these reasons slavery and human trafficking is a matter of zero tolerance at Corehard Limited.

All staff involved in the engagement of suppliers must communicate our zero tolerance approach to all prospective parties at the outset of our business relationship and monitor our approach as appropriate thereafter. We may terminate our relationship with third parties engaged with us if they do not comply with this policy

This policy applies to all employee's, agents, consultants and those parties in our supply chain wherever in the world they operate. Any reported breach of this policy will be investigated and may lead to disciplinary action which subsequently could result in employee dismissal.

Responsibilities

The detection and reporting is the responsibility of all of us. You should raise any concerns about any issue or suspicion of modern slavery in any part of our business or supply chain at the earliest stage.
